Application Tips

- If you're creating a lineup with stored schedules for a live show, remember to adjust for time zones! The easiest way to do this is to create a separate lineup for stations in each respective time zone, then create a master composite lineup. (ACT 1 assumes all dayparts are the local times for each station. If you have a lineup of stations in California and New York, using a global 'MF10a3p' will not result in M-F 7a-12n for California.)
- To enter a 15-minute daypart, you can use a shortcut for times that begin at :15, :30, and :45 past the hour by just entering the day(s) and start time (e.g., 'MF1115a' will return M-F 11:15am-11:30am). To use this shortcut on the hour, make sure to enter the zeros (e.g., 'MF1100a' will return M-F 11:00am-11:15am, while using 'MF11a' results in M-F 11:00am-12:00n).
